Twenty-Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time

We gather in the name of Christ Jesus the Lord to worship our God-Father, Son and Holy Spirit- through Christ and with him and in him.

First Reading: Exodus 17: 8-13

The story of Moses praying on the mountain top while his people battle their enemies below, and sometimes needing help to keep his arms raised in prayer, reminds us of the importance of perseverance in prayer in our journey through the desert towards God.



Second Reading: 2 Timothy 3:14-4:2

Paul encourages young Timothy to be constant in his prayerful reading of Scripture, which is inspired by God to enlighten and strengthen believers, and to continue manfully in the task of proclaiming the message, the Gospel. That sums up the Church's mission.

Gospel Reading: Luke 18: 1-8

Luke introduces today's Gospel reading with an important message for us. He says that Jesus told his disciples a parable about the need to pray continually and never lose heart.
