### Fourth Sunday of Easter Good Shepherd Sunday – Vocation Sunday Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> / Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> April 2016

Pope Francis has charged the whole Church with the responsibility of caring and praying for vocations. The World Day of Prayer for Vocations is observed on April 17<sup>th</sup>, with the theme "The Church, Mother of Vocations". In his message for the Day of Prayer, Pope Francis reminds us that all vocations are born in the Church, and that a calling is not "for a particular region, or for a group or for an ecclesial movement, but rather for the Church and for the world."
