By seventeen years of age, Clare was profoundly influenced by the life and preaching of Francis - Gospel Brotherhood, the love of Jesus,, the emptiness of worldly glory, and the joy of focusing one's life on the following of Jesus. By fleeing from her family home Clare renounced the power and prestige of her noble class, determined to live the Gospel life of Poverty and Contemplation as Francis did, building her life henceforth on the Person of Jesus. Many noble women followed her .Thus began the Second Order of St. Francis, the Poor Clares. We celebrate her feast on August 11th.
