**Second Reading: Apocalypse 1:5-8**

These four verses from the first chapter of the Apocalypse are rich in insight into the mystery of Jesus Christ and of the salvation he has won for us by his blood.

**Gospel Reading: John 18:33-37**

Jesus acknowledges that he is a king, but that his kingdom is not of this world. He has come to bear witness to the truth. If we are on his side, the side of truth, we listen to his voice.
